

The AMI Quattro doesn't work anymore.

Your problem with the AMI Quattro, saying "Await Mixer and Group pause" has occurred because someone has started a group which was empty. No valve numbers represented in the groups:

Also be sure that some time has been chosen:


Irrigation time valve 1 **00:30** min.

Irrigation time valve 2 **00:30** min.

Irrigation time valve 3 **00:30** min.

Irrigation time valve 4 **00:30** min.

After this is done, please go to the Mixer menu:



Mode selector: Mixer

Off The mixer is switched off.

Man.start The mixer is mixing until the mode selector is set on 'Off' or 'Aut. start'.

Aut.start The mixer is started automatically, either by the internal irrigation controller, or by an external irrigation controller.

Do like this:

Set Mode selector: Mixer at **Off**

Go back to the Main menu.

Wait more than ½ minute.

After this is done, please go to the Mixer menu again:

Set Mode selector: Mixer at **Aut.start**

What happens now is, that an irrigation starts and stops after a while.

The problem is now solved!
